1839-1859	Sandy Ridge (Eleventh & Washington) & Potter Field (Columbus & Saginaw) used for burials
1851-52	Oak Ridge Cemetery started 1866 formal burial grounds
1858	Judge James Birney III started Pine Ridge (Birney) Cemetery (Died May 8, 1888 buried in Pine Ridge)
1861-1864	Civil War
1863	St. Patricks Cemetery established
1868	Eickemeyer (Green Ridge) Cemetery started
1882	George D. Seaman, Sexton - resides in cemetery Sexton for Green Ridge 1873-1899) (Died March 2, 1899 buried in Seaman's Cemetery)
1884	Pine Ridge 1 st Addition Plotted
1887	John Condon, Sexton
1888	Sophia (Birney) Blackwell took over cemetery (Died January 25, 1909 buried in Pine Ridge)
1888	Soldiers Rest laid out in May
1888	Seaman's Cemetery plotted
1889	Soldiers Rest deeded to Grand Army of Republic
1890-1899	Charles D. Fisher, Sexton (Died July 27, 1899, buried in Pine Ridge)
1891	Elm Lawn Cemetery opened
1899-1952	Charles C. Cuthbert, Superintendent & Sexton (Died 1952, buried Green Ridge Cemetery)
1900-1931	George W. Ames owned cemetery
1953-1960	Pine Ridge Cemetery Association caretakers
1968-1990	Lewis (died Oct 9, 1985) and Dorothy Moore (died October 18, 1999) both buried in Pine Ridge, managed cemetery & records
1987-2009	Dave & Delores Rogers caretakers
1999	Friends of Historic Pine Ridge Cemetery caretakers
2000	Last found burial Grace Geister, August 24, 2000
2002	Ted Anderson, Sexton
2009	New Dimensions caretakers
2009-Present	Ron Graham caretaker
2014	Renamed to include Soldier's Rest in name
2014	Friends of Pine Ridge Cemetery started
